1. HILLINGDON

Hillingdon Direction: Please park in Maternity car park entrance B . Walk up the ramp towards A&E, enter the first double door on the right. Walk through outpatients, Look for the signs showing Orthopaedic Fracture clinic 1. OOH reception is located in fracture clinic. Hillingdon hospital operates a park and display car park

2. HOUNSLOW

Hounslow Direction: Skyways Medical Centre is near the BP Garage off Burns Way – Limited parking is available on site but patients can park on the main road at Skyways. Once at the GP surgery please report to the OOH receptionist.

3. HARROW

Directions: Go along Watford Road and turn into hospital. Follow the signs to Car Park 1 - Multi Story Car Park. Once parked make your way to the Main Entrance of the hospital. Once through the double doors, turn right where you will find Outpatients Department. The OOH reception desk is situated in Outpatients 5 area.

1. Kingston PCC:

Directions: From the main car park on Galsworthy Road, walk in direction of the Accident & Emergency Department towards the right-hand side of the main building. Before reaching A&E you will pass the main out patient's department; upon entering, the phlebotomy department is immediately on the left-hand side.

2. Oak Lane PCC:

Directions: The OOH Clinic is based within this GP Surgery which is easily visible along Oak Lane, with parking available outside.

3. Croydon PCC:

Directions: Enter via ED where the reception is on right. Proceed till vending machine on right, after which there is set of double doors with GP Out of Hours above. Proceed to walk upstairs to 1st floor. Turn right where entrance is located for the service. Ring bell to alert receptionist. For reduced mobility, keep walking past double doors where there is a 2nd door on the right for lift access into service.

4. Queen Mary's PCC:

Directions: Turn off Roehampton Lane into Queen Mary Hospital; the paid car park is on your right, with the hospital on your left. When walking into the main entrance to the hospital, the UTC / MIU entrance where the OOH is based is just outside the main door on the right-hand side. It is a short walk from the car park.

5. St Georges PCC:

Directions: From the main car park, walk towards A&E and turn right to get to the St James Wing entrance. Walk down the corridor past the lifts and turn right. Walk down this second corridor until you see signs for Outpatients and enter the outpatient department. The OOH reception is in front of you to the right.

6. St Helier PCC:

Directions: The OOH clinic is based in Ferguson House, which is separate to the main building of the hospital, but easily accessible from the car park. It is a walk down the main a corridor and, in an area, called the Springall Annexe, which is up a few steps. For disabled access, the Springall Annexe will need to be accessed from round the back of Ferguson House.
